



We respond to requests under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

Please find attached a map and spreadsheet of the landfill site. The site was closed prior to our formation so we hold limited data.

The site is not designated as a Special Site under Part IIa of the EPA 1990. The Environment Agency only regulates Special Sites. The local council regulates all other contaminated land sites and maintains the Contaminated Land Strategy. Please contact the relevant local authority for further information. This would include any necessary land monitoring.

We have checked our Groundwater and contaminated land records and hold no data for this site. Please be aware that we only consider risks to groundwater. The local council's Environmental Health Department is responsible for risks to other receptors (for example human health, property and ecology) and should be contacted for further information.
