**Application by Highways England for an order granting development consent for the M25 Junction 10/A3 Wisley Interchange improvement project - response to Secretary of State letter of 16<sup>th</sup> August**

**Matter 1: Request for comments from Interested Parties on the Applicant's response to the Secretary of State's letter of 26 July 2021**

The County Council has reviewed the information that was submitted by Highways England in response to the Secretary of State's consultation letter of 26<sup>th</sup> July 2021. As Lead Local Flood Authority we agree with their conclusions in table 3-1 (climate vulnerability cumulative effect assessment) of the report that there is unlikely to be any change in significance on flood risk impact.

We would have expected section A.4 Figure 4 – Risk of flooding to include surface water flooding extents to give a full picture of the risks. Notwithstanding this omission, the conclusion would likely remain the same as in this area the surface water and fluvial flooding are in similar locations and to a similar magnitude.
