Dear Secretary of State for Transport,

I am the chair of Bulphan Village Community Forum, in Thurrock.

Our community believes that the current £10 billion Lower Thames Crossing project is not fit for purpose and therefore the DCO should not be granted.

The present proposal will go very little towards solving the congestion problems at the Dartford Crossing. There are more sustainable solutions which will not have such a negative impact on the climate emergency and will have much more impact on the congestion problems.

If the present proposal is granted, in a few years we will be faced with just as much congestion, lots of money spent ineffectively, huge carbon emissions from construction of the crossing and no real solution to any of the problems which this proposal is intended to solve.
