The Planning Act 2008 s.55 (3) states that 'The [F1Secretary of State] may accept the application only if the [F1Secretary of State] concludes — (f)that the application (including accompaniments) is of a standard that the Secretary of State considers satisfactory.'

Please would you clarify what standard is considered satisfactory for an application for a DCO for a road scheme that is a national infrastructure project with respect to its Environmental Statement and the Case for the Scheme. Are there criteria that must be met?
