## Amendment to the Application and inclusion of additional land

The Examining Authority (ExA) has accepted a proposal to amend the application and include additional land [PD-012]. The Applicant has certified that this proposal has been publicised in accordance with Regulations 7 and 8 of the Infrastructure Planning (Compulsory Acquisition) Regulations 2010.

Three further Relevant Representations were received [RR-042, RR-043 & RR-044]. In accordance with Regulation 11 of the Infrastructure Planning (Compulsory Acquisition) Regulations 2010 the ExA has made an initial assessment of the issues arising in connection with the proposed provision and has decided that the issues remain as set out in Annex E to our letter of 21 December 2018. There are no new issues arising. The ExA has decided that it is not necessary to hold a meeting to discuss how the proposed provision should be examined. The provision will be examined by Written Representations and by holding further hearings. The Examination Timetable has been amended accordingly (see Annex A)
