This site is immediately to the west of Long Hazel Park, Sparkford.

A traffic noise mitigation report and scheme has been submitted at the behest of South Somerset District Council Environmental Health Department to support the above Planning Application. The acoustics expert Tegwyn Jones for the Applicant here (being the same expert in our submissions for Long Hazel Park at the examination stage by the Planning Inspectorate) has concluded that a 3 metre high acoustic barrier along the boundary of the proposed site with the A303 should be erected to protect the residents from A303 traffic noise. He concluded the same about our site. Please see
