Thank you for your 5 October 2022 consultation of Interested Parties.

Anglian Water notes that one of the concerns of Natural England is the management of surface water. With reference to the draft DCO we note the requirement for additional drainage details to be approved following consultation (see draft Requirements 4 and 8). In order to ensure that any proposals to connect surface water drainage — temporarily or permanently — to the pubic sewer network do not cause pollution and the loss of biodiversity which Natural England have concerns over we would recommend that Anglian Water is added to the list of consultation bodies consulted under Requirements 4 and 8.
