	There is no relevant detailed extract for the DCO area.

	infrastructure. Also of relevance are policies LP 10 which seeks to protect the		
	countryside and the best and most versatile agricultural land; it should be noted		
	that the Nene Valley land within Huntingdonshire is classified as agricultural grade		
	4 and therefore is not subject to protection through this policy. Policy LP 11 is also		
	relevant in that it seeks to ensure that any proposal responds positively to its		
	context and helps to create a high quality place; this acknowledges the guidance provided in the Landscape and Townscape SPD which contains a section on the
