
A representative of the Lead Local Flood Authority (Elaine Simpson – Senior Flood Risk Officer) wishes to attend the accompanied site inspection scheduled for 19 November 2019, to be able to point out features relating to local flood risk, and suggest the following locations:

- Eastern Side – corner of A1243 (Southgates / South Deans Road) and Newcastle Road – historical flooding (Easting:652576 Northing:306380) – parking on roadside
- Western Side – Ordinary watercourse culvert and low ground next to ordinary watercourse from Queen Anne's Road (Easting:652182 Northing:305953) – Parking roadside on Suffolk Road (north or south of Williams Adam Way)
- Western Side – Catchment of ordinary watercourse, and overview of site from pedestrian bridge over Williams Adam Way (Easting:652252 Northing:305856) Parking roadside on Suffolk Road (north or south of Williams Adam Way)
- Western Side – Southtown Common, catchment of Ordinary Watercourse and culverts, and looking towards historical flooding locations (Easting:652178,

Northring:305829) - Parking roadside on Suffolk Road (north or south of Williams Adam Way)
