Technical Note and Statement of Common Ground

Dear Sirs

Further to your email of 16 February 2022, please find our response below.

The Flood Risk Assessment (FRA) Technical Note (TN) Ref TR01004/EXAM/9.82 Rev 2 (dated 15 February 2022), including the Appendices, submitted at deadline 10, is acceptable to us.

Our agreement to the SoCG is subject to the FRA TN submitted at deadline 10 being listed as a certified document as part of the FRA within Schedule 10 of the DCO. The TN must be recognised as part of the FRA for Requirement 21. We also note that some of the wording on page 59 of the dDCO deadline 10 in Requirement 1 is missing, the word 'note' after technical – this word is required to ensure the TN is an integral part of the overall FRA.

It should be noted that the TN is referred to as Rev 3 in the SoCG, but Rev 2 in the TN (we consider this a typographical error). We find the scheme acceptable, subject to the above changes and Requirements 3, 14 and 21 along with our agreed Protected Provisions being duly placed in the DCO.
