The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 (as amended) – Rules 8(3) and 9

Application by Highways England for an Order Granting Development Consent for the M54 to M6 Link Road Project

Notification of decisions on proposed change, Site Inspections, Hearings scheduled for March 2021, and associated matters.

We write further to the letter from the Applicant dated 12 February 2021 in respect of matters submitted at Deadline 6.

In that letter the Applicant submitted a revised Street, Rights of Way and Access Plan (Examination Library [REP6-002]) which includes an access to the plot to west and north of Plot 4/20c as shown on the Land Plans [REP6-004].

Although not formally requested as a change, the Examining Authority (the ExA) considers that this should be considered as such.

The ExA has reviewed the information provided and assessed the Applicant's letter in line with paragraphs 109 to 115 of DCLG Guidance 'Planning Act 2008: Examination of Applications for Development Consent' and the Planning Inspectorate's Advice Note 16.

The ExA notes that the identified amendment to the design is set within the red line boundary for the scheme and would not result in a materially different project. The Applicant has been in discussions with those who would be directly affected by the proposed change. The ExA accepts that the proposed change would still allow for the Examination to be completed within the statutory timetable of six months (section 98(1) Planning Act 2008 (as amended)). It would represent a minor design change.

The ExA is therefore able to accept the above matter as a non-material change to the application.



Site Inspection

In its letter of 29 January 2021 the ExA asked the Applicant to provide 360° and video photography in the event that a Site Inspection could not be undertaken. The ExA also set up a mechanism whereby Interested Parties could make observations on the information submitted in the same way that they would have been able to do at an Accompanied Site Inspection, that is to point matters out for the ExA to specifically observe.

In that letter the ExA confirmed its preference to physically visit the site and this remains its intent. It is therefore communicating with the Applicant via the Case Team to ask it to arrange Site Inspections in the expectation that this is possible. These would take place in the window allowed for in the Examination Timetable (16 and 17 March 2021).

The ExA does not wish to be accompanied in these Site Inspections other than if necessary, to be let on to the relevant land and/or to be advised of any health and safety implications. Parties should therefore work on this basis and are asked to make arrangements in those terms.

As set out above, through the submission of the 360° and video photography any Interested Parties will still be able to point out particular matters that they would like the ExA to note. This would be in line with the timetable set out in the letter of 29 January 2021.

March Hearings

Having carefully read the information submitted to date the ExA has concluded that it no longer needs to hold Hearings in March 2021, which are therefore cancelled.

However, this does not mean that the ExA does not have any further questions of parties, or that it will not have any questions following the Site Inspection. If there are any such questions, the ExA considers that they are likely to be specific to particular parties and are therefore likely to write to those parties directly under the provisions of Rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 (as amended).

Such correspondence would be published on the project webpage in line with normal procedures.

Changes to the timetable

To accommodate this Procedural Decision, the ExA has also made a Procedural Decision to make changes to the Examination Timetable from that published on 29 January 2021. These are:

- To remove Procedural Deadline F (Confirmation as to wish to participate or observe the Open Floor Hearings, Issue Specific Hearings, Compulsory Acquisition Hearings and Accompanied site visit in March (if required))
- To amend the entry for 16 March 2021 to 'Examining Authority's Unaccompanied Site Inspection 16 and 17 March 2021'
- To remove 'Post March 2021 Hearing submissions including written submissions of oral case (if required)' from Deadline 7

Consequently, the ExA has published at **Annex A** a revised Examination Timetable taking into account all matters to date.

Other matters

The ExA is aware that it is due to publish shortly its draft Report on the Implications for European Sites (RIES) and proposed schedule of changes to the draft DCO (if required), and considers it would be useful, particularly, in respect of any changes to the draft DCO to explain its thoughts.

Any changes published at that time are likely to be of a typographic nature or where any change is considered to be of more minor importance. This does not mean that the ExA considers these would be all the changes that may be necessary.

Other matters have been and continue to be examined but it is clear that there are fundamental differences between parties on a number of issues. These will need to be reported to the Secretary of State along with the ExA's conclusions when all the evidence has been submitted.

It is possible that the ExA's conclusions may result in further changes to the final version draft DCO as submitted by the Applicant at Deadline 8 (7 April 2021) which would then form part of the recommended DCO (should the ExA consider that the DCO should be granted, or if the ExA considers that the DCO should be withheld, should the Secretary of State disagree with that conclusion).
