1. Request for an update on outstanding Protective Provisions

The Secretary of State notes at the close of the examination Severn Trent Water ("STW") expected the Applicant to continue to engage with STW to reach a final agreed position to cover the on-going approvals process for protection and diversion of STW's assets and to provide acceptable cover for STW's liabilities. Could the Applicant and STW provide an update on the current position?
