Planning Act 2008 and the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010

Application by Gloucestershire County Council ("the Applicant") seeking Development Consent for the proposed M5 Junction 10 Improvements Scheme ("the Application")

Request for comments from the Applicant and the parties listed above

Responses to the Secretary of State's consultation <u>letter of 21 March 2025</u> have now been published. Responses were provided by the <u>Applicant</u> and the <u>Department for Environment</u> Food and Rural Affairs.

CROWN LAND

It is noted that **the Applicant** and the **Crown Estate Commissioners** were expected to provide additional information in relation to an agreement for the voluntary acquisition of land (identified in the Book of Reference as plots 14/5a and 14/7a) and this information was anticipated by 30 April 2025. Given this concerns a statutory condition for the purposes of the proposed Order, this issue should have been resolved during the Examination phase of the Application at the latest, and it is disappointing that this issue remains unresolved to date. This appears to be a reoccurring issue outside of this Application that the Department will be picking up with the Crown Estate Commissioners and HM Treasury. However, in relation to this Application, the Secretary of State invites both parties to provide their earliest update on the agreement and requests confirmation from the **Crown Estate Commissioners** as to whether Crown consent can be granted.
