1 Walker, cyclist and horse-rider survey results

- 1.1.1 Walker, cyclists, and horse-rider (WCH) counts were undertaken at 17 locations within the vicinity of the proposed A46 Newark Bypass (the Scheme); see Appendix A (Walking, Cycling and Horse-riding Survey Locations) of this Report for locations. Details of the survey methodology used is detailed within Appendix E (Walking, Cycling and Horse-Riding Assessment and Review) of the Transport Assessment [APP-193]. Chapter 12 (Population and Human Health) of the Environmental Statement (ES) [REP3-011] contains the assessment on WCH routes.
- 1.1.2 Each site was surveyed from 6am to 10pm on both a weekday and a weekend in early spring 2023 (between March and April). Manual surveys were carried out with two members of staff per eight-hour shift. The surveys categorised flows for pedestrians, pedestrians with dogs, pedestrians with a pram or pushchair, mobility impaired users, wheelchair users, joggers, cyclists and equestrians.
- 1.1.3 Surveyed routes include walking/cycling routes along highway routes, as well as formal footpaths and bridleways. Two surveyed locations (Site 6 and Site 9) are not considered Public Rights of Way (PRoW). However, these have been surveyed due to their proximity to the A46 and evidence of use.
- 1.1.4 Table 1-1 sets out the result of the WCH surveys.
