## PROTECTIVE PROVISIONS

- 1. The Secretary of State notes that an agreement on the wording of the Protective Provisions for the benefit of National Grid Electricity Distribution (East Midlands) ("NGED") has not been reached. The **Applicant** and **NGED** are asked to provide an update on the current position of the Protective Provisions and whether an agreement has now been reached. If so, the parties are requested to provide their agreed wording for the Secretary of State's consideration
- 2. Where an agreement has not been reached, **the Applicant** and **NGED** are asked to set out their respective proposed wording or their view on what is needed to resolve the concerns.

## **CROWN LAND**

3. In its response of 30 July 2025, the Applicant indicated that consent for the acquisition of interest in land held by the Crown, is not required as the land has been disclaimed and will escheat. Confirmation is requested from the Crown Estate Commissioners as to the status of the land and whether it is agreed that the consent of the Crown is not required.

The deadline for response is 27 August 2025.
