1. Introduction

1.1. General

- 1.1.1. These Classification of Roads Regulation Plans (these "Plans") relate to an Application made by National Highways (the "Applicant") to the Secretary of State for Transport via the Planning Inspectorate (the "Inspectorate") under the Planning Act 2008 (the "2008 Act") for a Development Consent Order (DCO). If made, the DCO would grant consent for the A46 Coventry Junctions (Walsgrave) Scheme (the "Scheme"). A detailed description of the Scheme can be found in Chapter 2 (The Scheme) of the Environmental Statement (ES) (TR010066/APP/6.1).
- 1.1.2. These Plans forms part of a suite of Application documents and is included in the Application in compliance with Regulation 5(2)(o) of the Infrastructure Planning (Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 (the "2009 Regulations") which requires:
 - 5(2)(o) ".... any other plans, drawings and sections necessary to describe the proposals for which development consent is being sought, showing details of design, external appearance and the preferred layout of buildings or structures, drainage, surface water management, means of vehicular and pedestrian access, any car parking to be provided, and means of landscaping".
- 1.1.3. These Plans are also being submitted under Regulation 5(4) of the 2009 Regulations which states:
 - 5(4) "Where a plan comprises three or more separate sheets a key plan must be provided showing the relationship between the different sheets."
- 1.1.4. As these Plans are part of the Application documentation they should be read alongside and are informed by the other Application Documents, in particular Schedule 1 of the draft DCO (TR010066/APP/3.1), the Works Plans (TR010066/APP/2.3) and the Engineering Drawings and Sections (TR010066/APP/2.5).
