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1. Introduction

1.1. General

- 1.1.1. These Drainage and Surface Water Plans (these "Plans") relate to an Application made by National Highways (the "Applicant") to the Secretary of State for Transport via the Planning Inspectorate (the "Inspectorate") under the Planning Act 2008 (the "2008 Act") for a Development Consent Order (DCO). If made, the DCO would grant consent for the A46 Coventry Junctions (Walsgrave) Scheme (the "Scheme"). A detailed description of the Scheme can be found in Chapter 2 (The Scheme) of the Environmental Statement (ES) (TR010066/APP/6.1).
- 1.1.2. These Plans forms part of a suite of Application documents and is included in the Application in compliance with Regulation 5(2)(o) and 6(2)(vi) of the Infrastructure Planning (Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 (the "2009 Regulations") which requires:
 - 5(2)(o)".... any other plans, drawings and sections necessary to describe the proposals for which development consent is being sought, showing details of design, external appearance and the preferred layout of buildings or structures, drainage, surface water management, means of vehicular and pedestrian access, any car parking to be provided, and means of landscaping;"
 - 6(2) "if the application is for highway related development or for the construction or alteration of a railway, it must be accompanied by section drawings to suitable horizontal and vertical scales which show, by reference to Ordnance Survey or Chart datum:
 - a) The levels of the proposed works, including in particular and where relevant vi. drainage outfall details for highways;"
- 1.1.3. These Plans are also being submitted under Regulation 5(4) of the 2009 Regulations which states:
 - 5(4) "Where a plan comprises three or more separate sheets a key plan must be provided showing the relationship between the different sheets."
- 1.1.4. As these Plans are part of the Application documentation they should be read alongside and are informed by the other Application Documents, in particular Schedule 1 of the draft DCO (TR010066/APP/3.1).
