A46 COVENTRY JUNCTIONS (WALSGRAVE) – TR010066 RESPONSE TO ADVICE RECEIVED FROM THE PLANNING INSPECTORATE UNDER SECTION 51 OF THE PLANNING ACT 2008

The Planning Inspectorate (the 'Inspectorate') issued a decision on behalf of the Secretary of State to accept the above Application for examination on 12 December 2024. In doing so, the Inspectorate made some initial observations in relation to the Application and following issue of the decision, it provided National Highways ('the Applicant') with advice under section 51 of the Planning Act 2008 (PA2008) in respect of these observations ('the section 51 advice').

The Applicant has updated a number of application documents in response to the section 51 advice and now provides this updated documentation for the Inspectorate's consideration.

Table 1 below sets out how each particular aspect of the section 51 advice has been addressed.

3	Environmental Statement – Appendix 13.1 – Flood Risk Assessment (Doc 6.3) Whilst it is noted that the exception test appears to consider the requirements of Flood Zone 3b, the FRA does not provide specific information to differentiate between land within Flood Zones 3a and 3b. It is also unclear from the information presented whether the Proposed Development would result in no net loss of floodplain storage. The Applicant should respond to the Inspectorate as soon as practicable to confirm the location and extent of Flood Zones 3a and 3b and how this corresponds to the application of the exception test and the proposed flood mitigation/ compensation. If components would be located within Flood Zone 3b, the Applicant should provide confirmation that there would be no net loss of floodplain storage, in line with the principles of the exception test.	A technical note has been added as Appendix G to Environmental Statement – Appendix 13.1 – Flood Risk Assessment (TR01006/APP/6.3). Flood Zone (FZ) 3 is defined as the 1 in 100-year flood extent. This can also be referred to as FZ3a. In order to define the FZ3b extent, a 1 in 30-year flood event had to be simulated, which has done as part of the technical note. Section 10 of the Flood Risk Assessment has been amended to respond to this section 51 advice and provide reference to Annex G. Paragraph 11.1.19 of the Flood Risk Assessment has also been amended to provide further clarity regarding there beingno requirement for floodplain compensation.

4a	Plans The Applicant should ensure that all key features are clearly identified on plans. For example, on the Special Category Land Plans (Doc 2.8), plots 2/2 and 2/1e not clearly identified as open space land.	The Special Category Land Plans (TR01006/APP/2.8) have been reviewed and amended in accordance with the section 51 advice, hatching has been added to clearly identify the open space land (plots 2/2 and 2/1e) within the Order Limits and this has been added to the Legend. This is only applicable to Sheets 1 and 2 of the Plans.
4b	Also, in General Arrangement (Doc 2.6), the proposed maintenance layby and Hungerley Farm Overbridge are not clearly identified.	The General Arrangement (TR01006/APP/2.6) has been reviewed and amended in accordance with the section 51 advice, with labels added to clearly identify the proposed maintenance layby and the existing Hungerley Hall Farm Accommodation Overbridge. This is only applicable to Sheets 2 and 4 of the Plans.
4c	Statement of Reasons (Doc 4.1) Plots 2/2 and 2/1e should appear in the last line of the table as open space land only to be compulsorily acquired for a temporary purpose	The two plots of open space land are not being compulsorily acquired for a temporary purpose, they are only subject to temporary possession. The Applicant has therefore not added them to that entry in Table 7-1 of the Statement of Reasons (TR01006/APP/4.1).
4d	Environmental Statement - Appendix 7.1 – ZTV and Verified Photomontage Methodology (Doc 6.3) The cover page for the Environmental Statement Appendix 7.1 ZTV and Verified Photomontage Methodology has been incorrectly labelled as 6.1 instead of 6.3.	The front cover of Environmental Statement Appendix 7.1 ZTV and Verified Photomontage Methodology (TR01006/APP/6.3) has been amended to show document reference 6.3 instead of 6.1.
4e	Environmental Statement – Appendix 13.1 – Flood Risk Assessment (Doc 6.3) Whilst it is noted that the exception test appears to consider the requirements of Flood Zone 3b, the FRA does not provide specific information to differentiate between land within Flood Zones 3a and 3b (See accompanying s51 advice).	See Ref 3 above.





In addition to the changes made to directly respond to the section 51 advice, the Applicant has independently identified one amendment required to Environmental Statement Appendices - Appendix 8.11 Wintering Bird Report, where a figure has been amended.
