## A46 COVENTRY JUNCTIONS (WALSGRAVE) APPLICANTS POST MEETING NOTE OF THE PRELIMINARY MEETING AND OPEN FLOOR HEARING 1

Please find the following updates on items raised at the Preliminary Meeting and Open Floor Hearing 1 (OFH1) on Wednesday 7 May 2025.

The Examining Authority (ExA) sought feedback on the draft examination timetable at Annex D to the Rule 6 letter (**PD-006**). As set out in the Applicant's response to the Rule 6 letter (**PD1-015**) (the "Applicant's Response"), the Applicant requests that the examination timetable be shortened. The Applicant acknowledges this in accordance with the UK Government's commitment to expedite the determination of infrastructure projects in the UK.

In addition to the matters raised in the Applicant's Response, the Applicant urges the ExA to reconsider the draft examination timetable once it has had a chance to consider the local impact reports from local authorities and any written representations, due to be submitted at Deadline 1. The Applicant is confident that these documents, and the nature of any issues raised therein, will support its position that a shorter examination period will be sufficient for the purposes of this Application.

The Applicant also considers the absence of any registrants or attendees at the OFH1, and the resolution of the issue specific hearing on Thursday 8 May 2025 shortly after 12:30pm (while also allowing for a 45-minute break), indicates the Application is not complex nor controversial. The Applicant is confident that any outstanding issues can be resolved promptly, and it will continue to work with consultees to this end.

The Applicant understands that the examination timetable is ultimately a matter for the ExA, however it respectfully requests that these matters and those raised in the Applicant's Response be considered in support of the request for a shortened timetable.
