Dear Sir,

I'm appalled that this project is to go ahead without a direct connection into Walsgrave Hospital. When so much money is being spent to enable the flow of traffic on the A46 it is scandalous that the traffic jams that are an everyday feature of the approaches to the hospital are being brushed aside. The traffic delays affect every facet of hospital life. Ambulances are delayed with life threatening consequences both for the patients carried and the knock on effect further delaying responses to calls from people who may well need prompt response to a life threatening situation. Patients attending appointments with Consultants and the Consultants themselves suffer delays, as has happened to me. Having allowed what I thought was a more than adequate buffer I was late, however, the Consultant was even later. All staff, who work long hours as it is, have their working day made even longer sitting in traffic. The NHS is operating under severe strain as it is without this added burden. A direct connection from the junction into the Hospital is essential. This opportunity should not be passed over on cost grounds, what cost can be put on lives lost or permanently affected without it?
