Thank you for your assistance.

They really do need to be published and read before any final decision though, because they relate to a huge contravention of due process by the statutory bodies, particularly consultee and neighbouring council NHDC. This literally only happened the day after the 25th November deadline when North Herts District Council confirmed this.

At this point, sadly I have also noticed that my very first submission to this DCO was published only partially. It contained a link to a local government website with the very large document so that readers and Inspector could access this, however it is NOT working upon your Inspectorate website, therefore I believe the Inspector must have been deprived of these concerns altogether and never even learned of them. This is unthinkable.

That was not my error but entirely the Inspectorate's. Also the fact that North Herts District Council purposely waited until one day after the submission deadline to approve their plans within the very same boundary of this Airport DCO plan - means that now the two NSIP projects are literally merged on top of each other. This has huge implications both legal, practical and strategic.

Please can you relay all of this to the Inspector? Meanwhile I will notify the Wigmore Village and Stopsley Village Groups of this worrying development, because as we stand we are 6,600 worried members and another 3,200 even more worried members respectively, so we have nearly 10,000 very troubled people concerned about this and directly affected by it.
