Dear Ministers and Prime Minister

I attach a one-page letter **summarising the key threats to all our futures, and why we must REDUCE, not EXPAND, flying from UK.**

This is all factual, unlike the greenwash produced using public money by Luton's airport company, Luton Rising.

Five other documents are also attached. Please read this evidence.

Those promoting airport expansion are mainly foreign-owned airport operators. Luton is different – a council operating like a multinational corporate, with no thought for the health of residents.

Many of us worked hard for years on a voluntary basis, not backed by the misuse of big money, to submit evidence to the Luton Airport Public Inquiry.

Friends of the Earth's national legal team also worked hard, submitting evidence on Heathrow.

In May 2024 FoE won in the High Court against the government's inadequate climate plan.

Further airport expansion would risk contravening the Climate Change Act.

Many scientists are desperately concerned that little progress has been made on tackling the climate emergency declared in May 2019, nearly 6 years ago, and that soon effects being seen around the world will be irreversible.
