I wish to register my objection to the application seeking a two-year extension of the existing airport planning permission.

I am concerned that granting an extension would prolong the impacts associated with the development without adequately addressing the environmental, community, and infrastructure issues that were raised during the original planning process. In particular:

- Continued noise disturbance affecting nearby residents and communities.
- Increased air pollution and associated health concerns.
- Environmental impacts, including effects on wildlife, habitats, and carbon emissions.
- The potential for further disruption to local residents for an extended period.

Circumstances and planning priorities may have changed since the original permission was granted. Therefore, I believe any proposal requiring additional time should be subject to a full reassessment rather than an automatic extension.

For these reasons, I respectfully request that the application for a two-year extension is refused. If additional time is considered necessary, any extension should be limited to a shorter period solely to allow commencement of the approved works and should be subject to appropriate review and updated assessment requirements.
