As a resident of Ramsgate it is alarming me how little information is being provided, and I am required to try and find this out myself. Adding to this uncertainty, we had recently been looking at [REDACTED] in the area for our Son who passed his [REDACTED], we did have to consider the impact this might have over [REDACTED] which is highlighted in some of the documentation as being heavily impacted as it is under the flight path. Pollution and noise levels over this school would have a major impact on teaching, learning, and well being of the children.
