As stated at the Issue Specific Hearing on noise and vibration on 22/03/19, the proposed operation of Manston Airport has the potential to result in noise and disturbance to residents living within the Canterbury District, namely those in Herne Bay and Whitstable and surrounding settlements. Canterbury City Council raised in its Local Impact Report a number of matters following the review of the noise and vibration chapter of the applicant's Environmental Statement. In light of these matters, Canterbury City Council were unable to fully assess in its Local Impact Report the potential noise impacts on the amenity of its residents at the time of its submission.

It is acknowledged that additional information has been provided at Deadlines 3 and 4, where the applicant has sought to respond to the matters raised, including amendments to the draft Noise Mitigation Plan. Clarification on these matters was also provided by the applicant during the course of the hearing following questions from the noise consultants representing Thanet District Council and Canterbury City Council's Environmental Health Officer in respect of the ban on scheduled night flights and quota count. At the request of the Examining Authority, further information is to be submitted by the applicant in due course and Canterbury City Council will review this and provide comments by the necessary deadlines.
