Gentleman, we have communicated previously about the possibility of night flights at Manston and you have both said that you don't support them and that the sponsor Riveroak has confirmed to you that they are not required at all. However during the examination stage, further information and clarification has been provided which indicates that whilst scheduled night flights will not be required chartered night flights which are generally used for cargo operations will be required and hence the requirement for a quota count of around 3,000 movements per year. Is it your position that you will support night flights on this basis, I note that in the past Mr Gale has specifically referred to scheduled night flights so wondered if you had done this deliberately to ensure that non scheduled night flights were ok. Clarification of your position would be helpful so that the examiners can be properly informed on this important and crucial issue.
