Recently Kent County Council released the unemployment figures for Thanet which I am forwarding to bring your attention to the need to reopen Manston Airport, Thanet desperately needs jobs and the huge investment that RiverOak are offering us. - Thanet has an unemployment rate of 9.4% the highest in Kent. Well above the Kent average of 5.67%.

- Thanet has the highest unemployment rate of 10.6% amongst 25-49 year olds in Kent.
- Thanet has the highest unemployment rate of 6.7% amongst 50-64 year olds in Kent.
