Factors in favour of reopening Manston Airport to aviation.

From the viewpoint of a former Manston Air Traffic Controller and Private Pilot, and Thanet resident observed over 20+ years. I do not claim to be any kind of expert, but make this report by physical observation and data gleaned from the local media.

In simple terms:-

The creation of many permanent longterm jobs with Manston being active in aviation:- Very high

The creation of any permanent longterm jobs in Thanet without Manston:- Negligible

Current state of unemployment in the Thanet area:- High

Current state of antisocial behaviour through lack of employment:- High and increasing

Benefits to the taxpayer from an active Manston:- High through reduction of unemployment payments and costs of remedying the repairs to infrastructure caused by graffiti, vandalism etc.

Costs to the taxpayer by not approving the above:- High and rapidly increasing

Incidences of crime and drug abuse in the Thanet area:-

Increasing

The chance to reduce the above by creating employment by using Manston for aviation:- High
