**Application by Gatwick Airport Limited ("the Applicant") seeking Development Consent for the Proposed Gatwick Airport Northern Runway Project ("the DCO")**

My objection to a proposed northern runway at Gatwick airport is as follows;

I live in an area which is already severely affected by aircraft noise and I believe that a second runway with increased traffic would be even more unacceptable on nuisance, health and environmental grounds.
