I have the following comments on your expansion plans:

- I don't support the expansion of Gatwick Airport
- If the government does approve expansion, it should be subject to strict environmental, noise and other controls
- Specifically, you support the EA's noise insulation and surface access proposals
- The proposed noise limits, even as amended by the Secretary of State , do not achieve the policy requirements that the benefits of growth should be shared between the aviation industry and local communities and achieve a balance between growth and noise reduction. To achieve the policy the limits should be reduced further at a pace and to an extent that achieves a genuine sharing of the benefits of growth or the government should mandate alternative noise benefits, such as a ban on night flights.
- In any event expansion should be accompanied by a ban on night flights as mandated for Heathrow
- There should be noise limits for the all periods of the year, not just the peak summer period.
- There should be a process for renewing noise limits downwards over time.
