To whom it may concern,

We wish to hereby record that we are opposed to the expansion of Gatwick Airport.

If the government does approve expansion, we believe any expansion should be subject to strict environmental, noise and other controls, as we are affected in the TN2 area despite LGW claiming otherwise.

We support the EA's noise insulation and surface access proposals.

We believe that the proposed noise limits, even as amended by the SoS, do not achieve the policy requirements that the benefits of growth should be shared between the aviation industry and local communities and achieve a balance between growth and noise reduction.

To achieve the policy the limits should be reduced further at a pace and to an extent that achieves a genuine sharing of the benefits of growth or the government should mandate alternative noise benefits, such as a ban on night flights.

In addition, any expansion should be accompanied by a ban on night flights as mandated for Heathrow and there should be noise limits for the all periods of the year, not just the peak summer period.

There should also be a process for renewing noise limits downwards over time.
