We continue to oppose permission for the use of 'The Emergency Runway' as a means of Expansion by Gatwick Ltd and it's Investors.

It was highlighted by three M.P.s who spoke at the Planning Consultations and clearly understood by The Planning Inspectorate that the transport infrastructure surrounding and servicing the airport was already at full capacity; it was indeed laboured by Crispin Blunt, who was then an MP, Andrew Griffith and Tom Tugendhat, current M.P.s, that when an 'incident' occurs on either the London to Brighton Main Line or the motorways then there is chaos at Gatwick and the surrounding area.
