Dear Sir,

I am opposed to the proposed Gatwick expansion for the following reasons.

- I do not believe there is sufficient need to increase air travel through the expansion of Gatwick
- If however the Government does allow expansion, there needs to be strict controls on noise and environmental impact, especially night flights.
- There should be noise limits for all periods of the year for departures and arrivals and ground and plant noise, not just the peak summer period.
- Due process needs to be adhered to.
- Transport needs must be addressed. The local roads are already congested and unlikely to cope with any increase. Adequate infrastructure must be put in place and this must not become a financial burden for the taxpayer.
- Although there would be increased job opportunities, this will result in more pressure on local housing and services and these must be improved as part of any development.
- In view of the impact of climate change any increase in air travel, rather than a decrease, is unacceptable

I live on the flight path to Gatwick and any increase in flights will directly impact my quality of life. However the flights are arranged there will be an increase which is unacceptable for local communities
