I do not support expansion of Gatwick Airport. However, if expansion is approved, it should be subject to strict environmental controls relating to aircraft noise, noise insulation and surface access as proposed by the Examining Authority.

The proposed noise limits do not meet policy requirements that the benefits of growth should be shared between the aviation industry and local communities and achieve a balance between growth and noise reduction. To meet this policy the limits should be reduced further to achieves a genuine sharing of the benefits of growth or the government should impose alternative noise benefits, such as a ban on night flights. In any event, expansion should be accompanied by a ban on night flights as mandated for Heathrow, there should be noise limits throughout the year not just the peak summer period, and there should be a process for revising noise limits downwards over time.
