Dear Sirs,

We write further to our previous submission to state that we continue to object to the proposed expansion of Gatwick Airport.

However, if you are minded to approve the project, we urge you to make it subject to strict noise controls, take into account environmental considerations and problems associated with access to the airport.

Regarding noise please consider the following:

- Noise limits should be reduced further than proposed and sure a genuine sharing of the benefits of growth with the local communities
- All night flights should be banned
- Noise limits should apply all year round and not just to the peak summer months

Regarding access to the airport please consider the following:

- There needs to be greater investment by Gatwick in public transport
- Road infrastructure needs further improvement beyond just road widening

Regarding the environment:

- The development proposed will have one of the largest negative impacts on climate compared to any decision taken in the UK in recent years
- There is inadequate provision in the plans regarding water supply, drainage and the handling of sewage

Finally, Gatwick has not substantiated its estimate for future business travel with hard evidence. There is also no evidence for the economic benefit from further airport development. Instead development of Eurostar should be prioritised prior to airport expansion.
