Thank you for consulting the Ministry of Defence (MOD) on Secretary of State's approval to extend the completion period of the Able Marine Energy Park Development Consent Order reference 2014/2935, MOD reference DIO 10067141.

The Defence Infrastructure Organisation (DIO) Safeguarding Team represents the MOD as a consultee in UK planning and energy consenting systems to ensure that development does not compromise or degrade the operation of defence sites such as aerodromes, explosives storage sites, air weapon ranges, and technical sites or training resources such as the Military Low Flying System.
