STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS 10 TO 15 OF THE 2011 REGULATIONS REGARDING THE APPLICATION TO MAKE A MATERIAL CHANGE TO THE ABLE MARINE ENERGY PARK DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER 2014 (S.I. 2014/2935)

- I, **RICHARD MICHAEL CRAM**, Engineering Director at Able UK Limited, Billingham Reach Industrial Estate, Billingham, Teesside TS23 1PX, hereby solemnly, sincerely and truly declare and affirm that, in compliance with the requirements of Regulations 10 to 15 of the 2011 Regulations, Able Humber Ports Limited, whose UK Asset Manager is Able UK Limited ("the Applicant")—
- 1 Consulted on the proposed application by—
 - (a) serving, by posting by First Class post, on 15 April 2021 a notice of the proposed application to the required persons identified in accordance with Regulation 10(1) of the 2011 Regulations; and
 - (b) notifying the persons consulted that the deadline for the receipt of the person's response to the consultation was 26 May 2021 in accordance with Regulation 11 of the 2011 Regulations.
- A notice addressed to "Spencer Jeffries" of Northern Gas Networks Ltd at 1100 Century Way, Thorpe Park Business Park, Colton, Leeds, LS15 8TU was returned by the Royal Mail marked "Not at this address" and was subsequently re-served by posting by First Class post on 27 April 2021, to "Resident / Business Owner" of Northern Gas Networks Ltd, 1100 Century Way, Thorpe Park Business Park, Colton, Leeds LS15 8TU.
- 3 Northern Gas Networks Ltd has subsequently advised that they have no equipment in the area affected by the proposed material change.
- In accordance with Regulation 12 of the 2011 Regulations the Applicant supplied to the Secretary of State such information in relation to the proposed application as the Applicant would supply to the Secretary of State for the purpose of complying with Regulation 10 if the Applicant were required by that regulation to consult the Secretary of State about the proposed application and that this was done on or before commencing the consultation.
- In accordance with Regulation 14(1) of the 2011 Regulations a notice of the proposed application was publicised in the prescribed manner by being published in each of the following publications—
 - (a) Grimsby Telegraph on Thursday 8 April 2021 and Thursday 15 April 2021;
 - (b) Scunthorpe Telegraph on Thursday 8 April 2021 and Thursday 15 April 2021;

- (c) London Gazette online on Thursday 8 April 2021 and in hard copy on Friday 9 April 2021;
- (d) Lloyd's List on Thursday 15 April 2021; and
- (e) Fishing News Weekly on Thursday 15 April 2021.
- In accordance with Regulation 14(2) of the 2011 Regulations the published notice included the following details—
 - (a) the name and address of the applicant;
 - (b) a statement that the Applicant intended to make an application to the Secretary of State;
 - (c) a summary of the main elements of the proposed application;
 - (d) a statement as to whether the proposed application involves EIA development;
 - (e) a statement that the documents, plans and maps showing the nature and location of the land were available for inspection free of charge on a website maintained by, or on behalf of, the Applicant;
 - (f) the address and place on the website where the documents, plans and maps could be inspected;
 - (g) a telephone number which could be used to contact the Applicant for enquiries in relation to the documents, plans and maps;
 - (h) the latest date on which those documents, plans and maps would be available for inspection on the website being a date not earlier than the deadline in sub-paragraph (k);
 - (i) details of whether a charge would be made for copies of any of the documents, plans or maps and the amount of any charge;
 - (j) details of how to respond to the publicity; and
 - (k) the deadline for receipt of those responses by the Applicant, being not less than 28 days following the date when the notice was last published.
- In accordance with Regulation 14(3) of the 2011 Regulations the Applicant arranged for a notice of the proposed application to be displayed at, or as close as reasonably practicable to, the land at a place accessible to the public.
- In accordance with Regulation 15 of the 2011 Regulations the Applicant has had regard to the relevant responses received before the deadline imposed.
