The following table has been prepared by the Applicant to set out the changes made to the dDCO submitted to the Examination at Deadline 2 (23 November).

It is submitted together with:

- a. revised dDCO (clean)
- b. a comparison version of the dDCO showing the changes from the submitted dDCO (APP-052; DCO Document Reference 3.1).

The Applicant has not fully updated Schedule 17 – the proposed certified documents – and anticipates that further updates to that schedule will be required.

The Applicant has also updated dDCO to reflect the suggested removal of Work 16D from the proposed authorised development. That change is however subject to the Panel accepting the Applicant's proposal for the removal of Work 16D and that removal being treat as a non-material change to the submitted DCO Scheme.

Until The Panel has indicated whether Work 16D can be removed, the Applicant will maintain its case for acquisition of the whole of Plot 05/85 and has therefore not updated the revised Land Plans (AS-012), revised Book of Reference (REP1-006) and Statement of Reasons (APP-055).
