Many thanks for your email of 11 March. My apologies for not responding sooner but the volume of work for Deadline 6 was significant.

I have considered your comments on Requirement 18 with my client.

The draft Requirement has been considered by the local planning authority in its current form and, as you will be aware from the Issue Specific Hearing, the draft is agreed between the Applicant and the relevant planning authority.

The MOVA system will be installed for the local highway authority to manage. The local highway authority will then have control over the MOVA system and regulate its operation. My client will not be involved in the day to day operations which will be in the hands of the local highway authority.

On that basis there is no purpose in having any further control or monitoring because the local highway authority will have control and will be able to regulate operations accordingly.

My client does not propose to modify the Requirement therefore.
