The Northampton Gateway Rail Freight Interchange Order 201X NOTICE PUBLICISING A STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Notice is hereby given that Roxhill (Junction 15) Limited of Lumonics House, Valley Drive, Swift Valley, Rugby, Warwickshire, CV21 1TQ (the "Applicant") proposes to apply to the Secretary of State (via the Planning Inspectorate) under Section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 for a development consent order to authorise the construction, operation, use and maintenance of a rail freight interchange (including warehousing and associated highway works) on land west of the M1 motorway at Junction 15 and east of the Northampton Loop Railway Line to include a bypass to the north of the village of Roade (the "Application").

As part of the proposals, the Applicant has a duty to consult the local community pursuant to Section 47 of the Planning Act 2008. The Applicant has produced a Statement of Community Consultation ("SOCC") for this purpose. The SOCC sets out the details of how the Applicant proposes to consult the people living in the vicinity of the land about the Application.

The purpose of this Notice is to inform interested persons and members of the local community that the SOCC can be inspected free of charge in the following locations from Thursday 14th September:

The Application is considered to require an Environmental Impact Assessment and therefore the Application will be accompanied by an Environmental Statement.

The SOCC sets out how the Applicant intends to publicise and consult on the Preliminary Environmental Information which will inform the final Environmental Statement.
