Thank you for your email inviting Natural England to attend the preliminary meeting for the Northampton Gateway Rail Freight Interchange. Natural England does not wish to attend the meeting.

Natural England are satisfied that the development is not likely to have an impact on the nearby Roade Cutting SSSI, provided that the CEMP references measures to safeguard Roade Cutting SSSI during construction, as stated in our Relevant Representation. All issues relating to European sites and protected species have also been addressed. We therefore have no major outstanding issues or concerns and do not envisage attending hearings. However, we would be happy to assist with further matters, including any changes to the proposed scheme, if required. We are willing to work with the applicant towards a brief Statement of Common Ground to this effect, as requested, if that would be helpful to you as far as our statutory remit extends. We anticipate that a draft SoCG will be prepared by the applicant for our review in due course.
