I would like to again raise my concerns for the proposed Hinckley NRFI I urge the Government to follow the inspectors recommendation to turn down the Tritax application. Tritax again has given little or no information on the concerns raised previously on additional pressure on our roads and infrastructure, issues around the noise, air quality and light levels particularly on the effects on our peaceful recreation area Burbage Common and the Aston Firs site. Tritax proposed changes to the village of Sapcote just won't work and will create a complete bottle neck at the crossroads in the village centre with lorries mounting the kerb to pass each other, its where children cross for school and people walk to the only village shop. The road bends at this point are currently a great way to slow the existing traffic down to a safe speed. My other concerns are the railway crossing at Narborough and the M69 junctions at the M1 and M6 the A5 is regularly blocked by Lorries hitting the most bashed railway bridge in the country which regularly already causes standstill traffic on the local roads. Within 10 miles of the proposed site we already have many rail freight sites please keep any more such developments along the A5 corridor. Please do not overlook the considerable concerns most people have across our local area. Please visit the area to see for yourself.
