

Middleton Stoney Parish Council is strongly opposed to this speculative proposal for the reasons set out in our earlier correspondence.

We welcome that traffic and transport have been identified in the initial assessment of principal issues by the Examiner, but would request that specific attention is given to the applicant's proposed mitigation. Our concern is that the relief road proposed to alleviate the huge blight on Middleton Stoney is not sufficient. In particular, we think the examination needs to consider the timing and extent of the proposed relief road. It should be in place before construction starts and should extend for 180 degrees rather than the proposed 90 degrees.
