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1 Pre-application Land and Rights Negotiations Tracker Introduction

1.1 Summary

- 1.1.1 This Pre-application Land and Rights Negotiations Tracker ('LRT') has been prepared on behalf of Southern Water Services Limited (hereafter referred to as 'the Applicant') and forms part of the Application to the Secretary of State under the Planning Act 2008 for a Development Consent Order ('DCO') for the Hampshire Water Transfer and Water Recycling Project, otherwise referred to as the 'Project'.
- 1.1.2 The Project comprises the construction, operation and maintenance of the following components:
- Water Recycling Plant and associated pumping stations.
 - Pipelines between Budds Farm Wastewater Treatment Works and the Water Recycling Plant site.
 - Pipelines between the Water Recycling Plant site and Bedhampton Springs, connecting to pipelines being delivered by Portsmouth Water between Bedhampton Springs and Havant Thicket Reservoir.
 - Pipeline between the Water Recycling Plant site and Otterbourne Water Supply Works.
 - Above Ground Plant comprising Intermediate Pumping Stations and Break Pressure Tanks located along the Pipeline between the Water Recycling Plant site and Otterbourne Water Supply Works.
- 1.1.3 The Project would also comprise the use of the following infrastructure:
- Havant Thicket Reservoir (which has been consented separately by Portsmouth Water and is currently under construction) for the storage of recycled water.
 - The existing Eastney Long Sea Outfall, Eastney Pumping Station, and associated Eastney Transfer Tunnel for the release of reject water from the WRP site.
 - Pipelines and other related works (which have been consented separately by Portsmouth Water) for the transfer of recycled water and source water between Bedhampton Springs and Havant Thicket Reservoir.
- 1.1.4 The construction and operation of the Project would be supported by other temporary and permanent works.
- 1.1.5 The Project will require the demolition, disassembly and/or temporary relocation of a number of small structures.
- 1.1.6 A detailed description of the Project can be found in ES Chapter 3 Description of the Proposed Development, Volume I (Document reference 6.1, DCO Volume 6).

The Application Glossary (Document reference 1.7, DCO Volume 1) sets out the abbreviations and definitions used in the DCO application for the Project.

1.2 Part 1 – Category 1 Interests (Owners)

- 1.2.1 Part 1 of the LRT includes all Category 1 owners identified within the Book of Reference (Document reference 4.3, DCO Volume 4) where the acquisition of freehold land, permanent rights and restrictions and temporary possession is required and the land interest is able to provide proof of title.
- 1.2.2 Where no interest has come forward, or ownership of unregistered plots has not been proven, negotiations are not ongoing, and the plots have not been included in the LRT. These plots will be kept under review during the Examination and if an interest comes forward, or evidence of ownership is provided, the LRT will be updated accordingly.
- 1.2.3 Where a land interest is identified within the Book of Reference (Document reference 4.3, DCO Volume 4) as having an assumed interest in respect of subsoil beneath a public adopted highway, such plots are excluded from the LRT as no voluntary land rights are being sought other than engaging with the relevant authority as part of the DCO process.

1.3 Part 2 – Category 1 Interests (Occupiers, Lessees or Tenants) & Category 2 Interests

- 1.3.1 Part 2 of the LRT will include all Category 1 occupiers, lessees or tenants and Category 2 interests identified within Book of Reference (Document reference 4.3, DCO Volume 4) that have made a relevant representation or where voluntary agreements are being sought separately to Category 1 owners. The Applicant is requesting such interests be signatories to voluntary agreements being sought with Category 1 owners where required.

1.4 Part 3 – Statutory Undertakers and Crown Authorities

- 1.4.1 Part 3 of the LRT includes interests identified as belonging to statutory undertakers within Part 1 of the Book of Reference (Document reference 4.3, DCO Volume 4) and provides commentary in respect of protective provisions and any voluntary agreements being sought.
- 1.4.2 While telecommunication operators are not statutory undertakers, they have been included in the table at Part 3 for completeness as persons identified with an interest or apparatus in the Order Limits who are therefore also subject to compulsory acquisition as part of the Application.
- 1.4.3 Crown authorities have been included where the Applicant understands consent is required pursuant to section 135 of the Planning Act 2008.

1.5 Other Interests

- 1.5.1 The Applicant is not proposing to enter into any voluntary agreements in respect of land held by Category 3 interests identified in the Book of Reference (Document reference 4.3, DCO Volume 4) where such land lies outside the Order Limits. Consequently, these Category 3 interests have been excluded from the LRT.

1.6 Explanatory Notes

- 1.6.1 Each tracker contains five sections from A to E, with each section broken down into further subsections.
- 1.6.2 Section A provides the name of the Affected Party as an individual land interest within the Order Limits, their unique reference number and the name and company of professional representation where applicable.
- 1.6.3 Section B provides the Examination Library references associated with any Relevant Representation, Written Representation or other document submitted by the Affected Party. Where the Applicant's response is assigned a document reference, this will be updated during Examination with the relevant Examination Library reference number.
- 1.6.4 Section C provides an overview of the status of any objection as well as a summary of any objection.
- 1.6.5 Section D provides detailed information in respect of the Affected Party's interest within the Order Limits, including the relevant plot numbers, works numbers and description of rights sought as per the draft DCO (Document reference 3.1, DCO Volume 3). For details on the plots please see the Book of Reference (Document reference 4.3, DCO Volume 4) and Land Plans (Document reference 2.2, DCO Volume 2).
- 1.6.6 Section E provides a status key and corresponding summary of the status of negotiations in respect of voluntary agreements being sought by the Applicant for the rights sought.
- 1.6.7 Table 1 explains the status colour provided in the Status of Negotiations column to reflect the following:
